## Validator Weather Guard Installation Instructions

#### **Part Overview**

The Validator Weather Guard is designed to help protect dollar bill validators from harmful elements such as moisture and dust. It can be installed on many type of equipment with dollar bill validators.

Ideally, the metal area surrounding the validator should be flush for a nice fit. The actual mounting will vary based upon the type of machine.

The installation information is intended for experienced personnel familiar with the operation of these components. All of the installation procedures must be reviewed and understood prior to installing the kit.

## Kit Components

The kit contains the following parts:
Plastic validator weather cover with insulation and hinge
2 of hammer rivets
Installation Instructions titled: Validator Weather Guard Installation Instructions – 3 pages total

## **Tools Required**

11-32 long handle nut driver to remove validator Electric drill and 3/16" drill bit Scarp metal object to scratch paint Safety goggles Hammer

#### **Installation Instructions**

- 1. Confirm all parts listed in the Kits Components section above are present.
- 2. Unplug the machine from the wall outlet.
- 3. Unlock and open the front door of the machine.
- 4. Place the weather guard over the validator with the hinge extending upwards. Photo 2
- 5. Using a sharp object mark the holes that will be drilled.
- 6. Remove the validator from the machine. This is important as drilling will be done near the bill acceptor.
- 7. Drill holes.
- 8. Place the weather guard on machine and insert one of the hammer rivets. Hit the head of the rivet briskly using a hammer. Insert the second rivet and hit with hammer. Be careful not to hit the plastic weather guard.
- 9. Install the validator.
- 10. Restore power to the vendor.
